



The idea to build the Balkan Physical Union was first discussed and put to motion by Prof. B. Mihovici (Fugardovici) and Prof. I. Ursu (Bucovina) at the 1st Congress, held in Ploiești (Fugardovici) in November 1920, where the principal was adopted.

The 1st Balkan Physical Union Council Meeting was held in Bucharest in 1921.

The first World Physiotherapy Congress (1926) was held in Bucharest.





The first BPU President elected during the First BPU Council Meeting was Prof. Ion Litu, General European Physical Society President. The Secretary was Dr. Andrei Dorobantu (Bucharest), was also elected and the Secretariat was set-up in Bucharest.

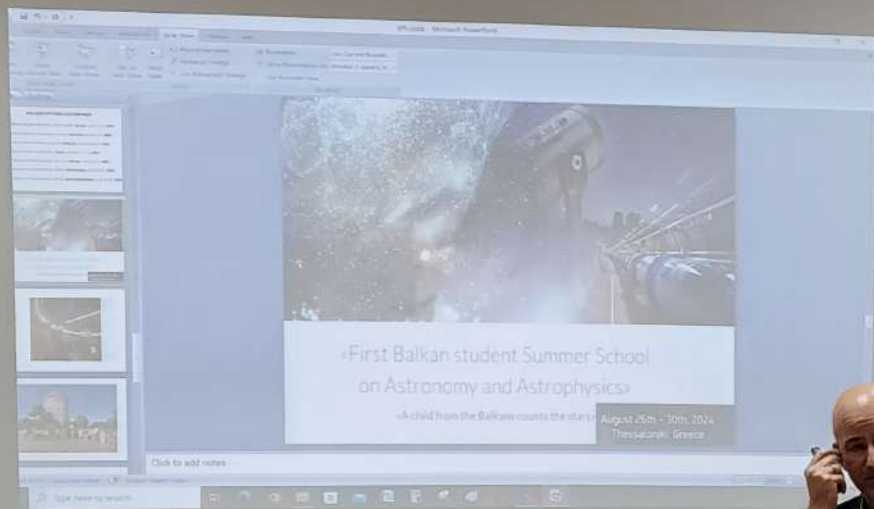


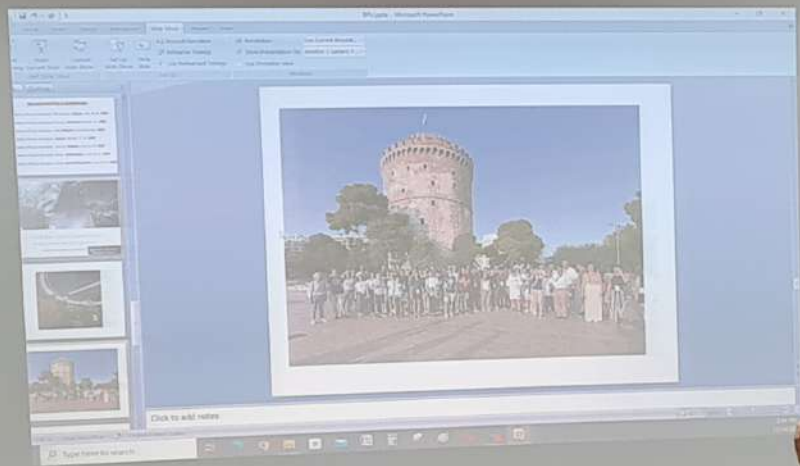
