



The idea to found the Balkan Physical Union was first discussed and put to motion by Prof. B. Mihalovici (Pugachev) and Prof. I. Ursu (Roussier) at the 1918 Congress, held in Plovdiv (Paphos) in November 1918, where the principal was accepted.

The 1st Balkan Physical Union Council Meeting was held in Bucharest in 1920.

The first World Physiotherapy Congress (1920) was held in Bucharest.





The first BPU President elected during the First BPU Council Meeting was Prof. Ion Litu, General European Physical Society President. The Secretary was Dr. Andrei Dorobantu (Bucharest), was also elected and the Secretariat was set-up in Bucharest.





